



GO+ VIDEO GUIDELINES

GO+ gives you the ability to download the lesson and music videos so you can incorporate them into your own virtual video lesson or use them for in-person services. Please follow the guidelines below for posting the original or edited GO+ Videos online.

POSTING GO+ VIDEOS ONLINE

If you want to post the GO+ lesson and music videos online or incorporate any of the GO+ videos into your own virtual video lesson and post them online, please follow our guidelines:

1. USE UNLISTED OR PRIVATE LINKS

If you use YouTube or Facebook or similar, please upload the videos as “unlisted” or in a “private group” and email the direct link to the families of your church. The GO+ materials should be accessible to the families of your church, but not to the general public.

2. LIMIT THE NUMBER OF VIDEOS AVAILABLE

Please make only one video available online at a time. When uploading a new lesson video to YouTube, social media, website, etc., please remove the previous one.

3. DOCUMENT THE COPYRIGHTED MATERIAL

A current GO+ subscription gives you the rights to use the provided copyright-protected GO+ material in your video. To properly do so you need to give documentation in the description or at the end of your video. The documentation needs to include: “**Copyrighted material provided by GO! Curriculum at www.gocurriculum.com and Crosskid Nation at www.crosskidnation.com.**” Always including this can help you avoid a mistaken removal or block.
